Safe Church Terms and Conditions

Through registration you have nominated yourself or another person as the responsible drop-off (at the event start venue) or pick-up person (at the event finish venue). Please show your ticket in paper form or from the email you received for each child that you or nominated carer/guardian registered at check-in time and for check-out.

This is a non-negotiable requirement as the session ticket enables your child to be checked-in and to verify you or your representative are authorised to pick up the child after the event. We may ask the nominated pickup person for photo identification before releasing your registered child/children into their care. Please provide your drop-off and/or pick-up person with this ticket if you cannot be there yourself.

On various occasions WBC collects personal information, including sensitive information about children and parents/carers. The purpose of collecting this information is to enable us to carry out our duty of care and to contact you if there is an emergency.

The contact information is used to communicate with parents/guardians about current and future program/session information using email, phone texting (SMS).

Health information about children is sensitive information within the terms of the National Privacy Policy under the Privacy Act. The only reason we ask for this is so that we can better care for your child. If we do not obtain this information, we may not be able to care for your child correctly in case of an emergency.

We will not disclose your personal information to third parties without your consent. By registering your children in this event, you can give or not give your consent for photographs and video footage to be taken during the event which may include your child/children's image, nametags, and voices. We will respect your wish and ensure your child is tagged clearly for no photo/video to be taken of them. If you do give consent, you also give your permission for WBC to use such recorded media in promoting similar future events through print or online.

It is also a legal requirement that we retain your personal and family information and your child/children's attendance record in our secure database to meet Safe Church and legislative requirements.

Your personal information is treated confidentially, collected, stored, used, disclosed, and destroyed in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 and our privacy policy, which sets out the way in which WBC complies with the Act.
