8. You will then need to enrol with our Registered Training Organisation - Vocational Bible College after your interview.

Course Fees:

Upon successful application you will be invoiced by Eastern for a \$600 deposit and then the estimated internship fee of \$3400, which can be paid in instalments each term.

A \$100 Administration fee will be invoiced by Woodvale Baptist Church for all student enrolments. Part-time students pay the same fee over 24 months. Audit students are directly invoiced by Woodvale Baptist each term.

Course costs include all learning and assessment guides and handouts provided in class. (These fees are based upon 2026 costs at time of sending and may vary slightly for 2026 /2027).

*Please note textbooks are to be sourced by students and will be advised before the start of each term. We do have a church library where textbooks and references can be borrowed to help with study costs. Subject to availability.
