Ministry: 1 day/week (may be split across the week)

Ministry

Roll up your sleeves, try out and develop your ministry skills. Churches work with their intern to develop suitable ministry placement/s where they can serve and grow. Depending on the need and an intern's gifting or desire, ministry placements can be as diverse as being involved in youth and kids, assisting or leading a small group, pastoral care, administration, music, chaplaincy, etc... there are numerous possibilities.



Individual mentorship from a member at your church

Formation

Position yourself before God with an expectation to grow. Regularly read your bible, pray and praise, journal reflectively, complete assessments and meet consistently with a mentor.



Classes run Thursdays during school terms

Equipping

Be equipped with skills and training to know God better and dig more deeply into the Bible. Learn how to apply God's word to life and ministry. Reflect on ministry opportunities and growth in the community and under different ministry leaders. The practical parts of the internship are in your church, however accredited trainers will deliver course content face-to-face at Woodvale Baptist campus, or online from our partners.

The Internship Program dates follow the Western Australian school terms. Apply now.

Costs

The fees cover tuition units and administration provided by Woodvale Baptist.
